Berlin Art Week 2022

A week full of contemporary art—Berlin Art Week and its partners host a diverse festival programme from 14—18 SEP 2022

Berlin, 12 SEP 2022. Preparations are going full steam: next Wednesday, Kulturprojekte Berlin will present the eleventh edition of Berlin Art Week. Together with key players in Berlin's art world, a diverse festival programme of contemporary art has been assembled. More than 50 partners will be holding exhibition openings, prize award ceremonies, and special events over five days.

In the words of Berlin's Senator of Culture Klaus Lederer, **»Each year, Berlin Art Week brings the Berlin art world together, from the artists to the galleries and project spaces, art fairs and museums. It provides an opportunity to discover Berlin and its many art offerings anew and means exciting encounters and a great deal of exchange for both Berliners and their guests. I wish us all a wonderful Berlin Art Week!«**

The more than 1000 artists include young and established artists such as Rachel Rossin, Lu Yang, Jenna Sutela, and Anna Uddenberg, performance art by Simone Forti and Leila Hekmat, group exhibitions by Tactical Tech, and retrospectives on Mona Hatoum. The fair Positions Berlin, the VBKI-Preis and a group of over 50 galleries across the city set important accents and show the importance of German capital domestically and internationally.

Berlin's Senator for Economics Stephan Schwarz emphasizes this special collaboration: **»Each year, the festival week is a highlight of the Berlin art calendar. This year, the galleries in particular increasingly demonstrate Berlin's significant position as an international art market: While the Positions Berlin Art Fair presents important positions from contemporary and modern art, the VBKI-Preis Berliner Galerien honors new and up-and-coming gallerists whose entrepreneurial efforts inspire the diversity of artistic production in the capital. An association of more than 50 Berlin galleries also presents Berlin as an aspiring art trading centre during the festival week. I am very pleased that we are able to support Berlin Art Week and thus promote the visibility of our young gallery owners in particular. «**

As a special highlight, this year's Berlin Art Week will be presenting its festival centre at Uferhallen in Wedding, placing a focus on Berlin as a centre of art production in the midst of numerous artist studios. With BAW Garten, open air and free admission, Berlin Art Week invites all those interested and curious about art from the neighbourhood and the surroundings to workshops, performances, and BAW Open Studios to exchange, discover, and participate. In addition, several artistic happenings will be taking place, from the

intervention ›Die Tore‹ with Rosa Barba, Maria Eichhorn, Herta Müller and Karin Sanderüber, the group show ›On Equal Terms‹ with artists from Uferhallen to ›Uferhallen Kunstaktien‹, a documentary show on Uferhallen as a location. Under the motto ›Explore Berlin Art Week‹, an extensive education and outreach programme will enable diverse ways of accessing the festival programme, highlighting a wide range of aspects of Berlin as a place for art and culture.

As part of the Kultursommerfestival, on the final day of the festival week—Sunday 18 SEP—participants will be opening their doors free of admission. The free admission Sunday is intended once again to help abolish access barriers to art and cultural institutions and to actively enable the cultural participation of all visitors and those interested in art.
